

Park Committee Meeting
Fire Station, September 19, 2003, 6:30pm

6 people attended. The meeting was video taped. No minutes from the previous meeting were read.

Discussion of bids for sidewalk - 3 bids reviewed:

- Pope Construction Company (Dick Pope). 4" thick, 5 ft. wide, 115 ft. length, mesh, pumper truck and bobcat included. Estimate: \$2484.
- South Florida Decking. 4" thick, 5 ft. wide, 115 ft. length, pumper truck. Add %500-600 bobcat cost. Form, place and finish. Grass removal responsibility of Association. Estimate: \$2,100.
- Crestline. 4" thick, 5 ft. wide, 115 ft. length. No mention of bobcat. Estimate: \$2,417.

Committee voted to recommend Pope Construction Company for installing the sidewalk..

Dick Pope also bid bobcat time to spread mulch at \$45/hr, vs previous bid of \$50/hr. Committee voted to have Dick Pope spread mulch. This money has already been approved, but the committee has not voted on a path(s) yet.

Clearing some other areas with the bobcat was brought up as a topic, since the board previously approved \$1,000 for spreading and clearing activity. Since the total amount available to spend is limited, the committee discussed the possibility of reallocating some of this money to other purposes.

The board (at the last board meeting) indicated there was \$4,000 available (balance of park budget + proceeds from last years golf tournament) for park enhancements for this year. However, the exact percentage of last years golf tournament to go to the park and front entrance might be reviewed again by the board and may favor slightly more than 50% to the park, as **all** of this year's Golf Outing will go to the Front Entrance. It was estimated that an additional \$800 might be made available.

Joy e-mailed a preliminary landscaping proposal to Tanya, but the proposal had not been distributed to other committee members at the time of this meeting. Landscaping generalities were discussed. Joy was asked to create a landscaping proposal to fall somewhere between \$800 - \$1,600.
